Prerequisites: Candidates must be 16 yrs. old and complete all online content and attend all classes. Successfully complete the swimming skills test; according to Red Cross Level 4

- Swim 25 yds each of: Front Crawl (freestyle), Back Crawl (backstroke), Breaststroke, Elementary Backstroke, and Sidestroke, and 15 yds of Butterfly.
- Maintain position on back for 1 minute in deep water (floating or sculling)
- Tread water for 1 minute
